1. Program information

1-1. Courses

- (1) Do you offer evening courses for working individuals?
 - Subprogram in International Education do not offer evening courses.
- (2) Do you offer online courses to obtain the IB educator certificates?
 - We do not offer the program only online nor the courses just for the certificates.
- (3) If I complete the two-year program, am I eligible to obtain the IB educator certificates?
 - The University of Tsukuba is recognized to offer the International Baccalaureate's (IB) Certificate in Teaching and Learning (IBCTL) and the Advanced Certificate in Teaching and Learning Research (IBACTLR), For more detailed information, please visit the webpages below.

- (4) Are the courses taught in English?
 - Course offerings in this specialization will include both courses taught in English and Japanese. Students wishing to pursue the IB Educator Certificates will have most of their course work delivered in English. There will be significant language support offered to Japanese speakers. While it is possible to complete this program completely in English, English speakers without Japanese proficiency will have limited course choice.

2. Entrance Exam

2-1. General

- There are three pathways into the program.
 - ✧ General Selection Process
 - ✧ Special Selection Process for Working Individuals
 - ✧ Special Selection Process for English Speakers and Overseas Japanese Nationals
 - All three pathways are open to students regardless of nationality but the two selection pathways other than the Special Selection Process for English Speakers and Overseas Japanese Nationals require Japanese proficiency.

- (3) Is it necessary to contact the professor before application?
 - It isn't. Prior contact with an academic advisor is not required to apply for the program. (Prior contact is required for applicants for the Subprogram in Education Sciences.)
- (4) Can I take the Subprogram in International Education exam in English to enroll in the Subprogram in School Education for the Next Generation?
 - You cannot. The Subprogram in School Education for the Next Generation is different from this program.

2-2. Special Selection Process for English Speakers and Overseas Japanese Nationals (hereby 'English SSP')

- (1) Is it possible to take the English SSP online from overseas without coming to Japan?
 - Yes, it is. Overseas residents can take the English SSP online. Please refer to the application guidelines.
- (2) I only have a graduation certificate, degree certificate, and academic transcript written in my local language other than English. Can I translate by myself?
 - No, you cannot. Please provide a certified translation. A photocopy will not be accepted. Please refer to Section 6 in the application guidelines.
- (3) Can I submit the original graduation certificate and degree certificate awarded at the time of graduation?
 - No, you cannot. As submitted documents are not returnable, please do not submit the original certificate but ask your university to issue the certificate of graduation/completion that proves your degree.
- (4) I have just completed a graduate program. Do I have to submit the graduation certificate, degree certificate and academic transcript only from graduate school?
 - You need to submit the certificates and academic transcript issued by the university which you have earned a bachelor's degree as well.
