- 1 Characteristics of the program
- The Professor in charge of In-Service Training for Overseas Teachers provides a special program for Teacher Training Students.
- There is a coordinator who supports the program.
- The program provides school visits.
- · High quality support is given from advisors and tutors.
- · A final report of the program is published.
- · A certificate of the program is issued.

- 3 Period of scholarship: October 2025-March 2027
- 4 Requirement for program completion

It depends on the supervisor, but students are required to attend Japanese language education(about 375 hours), compulsory lectures(1 credit, 2 lectures) and compulsory seminars(1 credit, 3 lectures). Then, students must make a final report.

- 5 Outline of the course
  - Japanese language education

: October 2025-March 2026

Intensive Course: 20 classes/week x 15weeks = 375 hrs.

- After these courses, students can take supplementary classes.
  - Specialized training:

[1 year course ] April 2026-March 2027

- Individual guidance is offered by each academic advisor according to each student's specialty. Students can attend lectures and seminars held by the advisor.
- Compulsory lectures "Educational Administration and Management" and "School and Educational Practice in Japan" are offered.
- 3) Compulsory seminars "Seminar for Final Report I, II and III" are offered.
- 4) Some of the lectures in the "Subprogram in International Education" in M.A. program and special lectures will be held.
- Participatory subjects

Participatory subjects such as school visits and international exchange at elementary, secondary and special education schools are provided.

#### Others

Visits to social and educational facilities, study trips, and Japanese cultural experiences (calligraphy, tea ceremony) are conducted.

## ♦ Follow-up for graduates

There is a follow-up program: We are organizing the international network of education with over than 396 graduates in past over than 43 years who were Teacher Trainees in University of Tsukuba.

## ♦ Accommodations

#### O Number of rooms

University of Tsukuba has 4 student residence areas: Hirasuna, Oikoshi, Ichinoya and Kasuga. Residence buildings accommodate both international and Japanese students. The full quota of people to stay in Student Housing (AY2025) is 3,517.

#### OType of rooms

One of 3 types of room will be allocated to a student based on the request and room availability.

- (1) Standard Single: 19,410 yen/month, 10m2
- (2) Twin room for single use: 23,670 yen/month, 30m<sup>2</sup>
- (3) Short Stay House room: 44,000 yen/month, 30m<sup>2</sup>

The University is located 60 km northeast of Tokyo, in the center of Tsukuba Science City. Mt. Tsukuba lies to the north and Lake Kasumigaura to the southeast. The campus is blessed with beautiful natural surroundings. It takes 45 minutes from Tsukuba station to Akihabara station by the Tsukuba Express Line.

Tsukuba Station, the nearest station to the main campus, is 45 minutes away from Akihabara Station on the Tsukuba Express Line.

The campus and halls of residence are 5–15 minutes by bus from Tsukuba Station. There are supermarket, convenience stores, electronics stores, bookstores, and post offices, etc. on campus.
